- ***Language:*** Students may fulfill the language requirement in one of the following ways: Completing any language class (other than English) beyond the 202 level, completing a 100 level language class in a language (other than English) that is different from the one used to complete the BA language requirement, or completing a 400 or 500 level course in Old English.
