- For AZ Dept. of Education teaching certification, students must apply for AZ iTeach their second year, and complete 11 credit hours of clinical experience and student teaching in their final two years. These requirements are coordinated through the Mary Lou Fulton Teachers College.
- At least 12 upper-division credit hours of ENG coursework must be taken with the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.
- A grade of C or higher is required in all courses taken for the major.
- A 2.50 cumulative GPA is required for graduation.
